ALL CONTESTS BETWEEN WCLO MEMBERS SHALL BE PLAYED ACCORDING TO 2024-25 NCAA RULE BOOK WITH THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS

Section 1: Rules specific to WCLO play:

- 1. No Shot Clock.
- 2. The clock will not stop for fouls in the 8-meter except in the last two minutes of each quarter.
- 3. The clock will stop for fouls in the 8-meter (offensive end) in the last two minutes of each quarter and on goals, unless there is a ten-goal differential.
- 4. If there is a foul in between the 8-meter and 12-meter the clock will not stop.
- 5. Games must consist of four, 15-minute quarters. Teams may decide whether to use a stopped clock or running clock on goals prior to the commencement of a game. This must be communicated with officials.
- 6. <u>No ties for any contest</u>. Games will go in overtime if the score is tied after regulation. The team that scores first during OT will be the winner of the contest.
